



OneBeacon Insurance Scholarship Program

THE PROGRAM

The OneBeacon Insurance Charitable Trust has established a scholarship program to assist employees', agents', brokers, and wholesalers' children who plan to continue education in college or vocational school programs. Scholarships are offered each year for full-time study at an accredited institution of the student's choice.

This scholarship program is administered by Scholarship Management Services[®], a division of Scholarship America[®]. Scholarship Management Services is the nation's largest designer and manager of scholarship and tuition reimbursement programs for corporations, foundations, associations and individuals. Awards are granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, gender, disability or national origin.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants to the 2013 OneBeacon Insurance Scholarship Program must be –

- High school seniors who plan to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two-year or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school for the entire upcoming academic year,
AND EITHER
 - 1) Children of full-time OneBeacon employees who have a minimum of six months of employment with the company as of the application deadline date and are still employed on August 1, 2013.**OR**
 - 2) High school seniors who are children of individuals employed by independent agencies, brokers or wholesalers that have represented OneBeacon Insurance for a minimum of one year and have a minimum of three years of continuous service with the agency, broker or wholesaler as of the application deadline date and are still employed on August 1, 2013.

AWARDS

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive a \$2,000 award. Up to eight (8) awards of \$2,000 each will be granted to children of employees, and up to eight (8) awards of \$2,000 each will be granted to children of individuals employed by independent agencies, brokers or wholesalers. Awards are provided for one year only and are not renewable.

To receive an award, the award recipient's parent must be actively employed by either OneBeacon or a OneBeacon distribution partner on August 1, 2013.

APPLICATION

Interested students must complete the application and mail it along with a current, complete transcript of grades to Scholarship Management Services postmarked no later than **April 15, 2013**. Grade reports are not acceptable. Online transcripts must display student name, school name, grade and credit hours earned for each course, and term in which each course was taken. Applicants will receive acknowledgment of receipt of their application. If an acknowledgment card is not received within three weeks, applicants may call Scholarship Management Services to verify that the application has been received.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, answer all questions as completely as possible. Incomplete applications will not be evaluated. All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed only by Scholarship Management Services.

SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, statement of goals and aspirations, unusual personal or family circumstances, and an outside appraisal. Financial need is not considered.

Selection of recipients is made by Scholarship Management Services. In no instance does any trustee or representative of the OneBeacon Insurance Charitable Trust play a part in the selection. All applicants agree to accept the decision as final.

Applicants will be notified in June. Not all applicants to the program will be selected as recipients.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarship Management Services processes scholarship payments on behalf of OneBeacon Insurance and the OneBeacon Insurance Charitable Trust. Payments are made in equal installments on August 15 and December 30. Checks are mailed to each recipient's home address and are made payable to the school on behalf of the student.

OBLIGATIONS

Recipients have no obligation to OneBeacon Insurance Charitable Trust. They are, however, required to notify Scholarship Management Services of any changes in address, school enrollment, or other relevant information and to send a complete transcript when requested.

REVISIONS

The OneBeacon Insurance Charitable Trust reserves the right to review the conditions and procedures of this scholarship program and to make changes at any time including termination of the program.
